

## Stain table textile floor coverings

### Stain remover for synthetic fibre carpeting:

- 1: Floor Mate (with active oxygen), Elatex
- 2: Super Stain Remover R

### Stain remover for natural fibre carpeting (pure wool, sisal etc.):

- 3: Alibaba

### The 4 basic rules of stain removal:

- 1.) Treat stains immediately. The earlier you treat the stain, the more simple and successful the removal.
- 2.) Generally treat stains from the edges to the middle in order to prevent spreading and smudging.
- 3.) Never rub firmly. Rubbing can lead to felting. Proceed calmly and in a relaxed way. Hurrying can lead to a worsening of the dirt or even to a damaging of the material.
- 4.) Exclusively apply suitable stain removers. Household remedies such as soft or neutral soap, washing up liquid, window cleaning agents, ammonia solution or turpentine can lead to a damaging of the fibre or new strong staining of the treated areas.

### Instructions and further remarks for correct stain removal:

- 1.) Take up liquids beforehand using absorbent cloths, vacuum up loose dirt.
- 2.) Identify stains by means of the stain table and select the stain remover recommended for their treatment.

- 3.) Always check the material to be cleaned with the stain remover with respect to colour and material consistency before the application.
- 4.) Spray stain remover onto a clean, absorbent, lint-free cloth and remove the stain by dabbing it from the edges to the middle. Special cloths made of machine-knit micro fibre have proved themselves in this respect. Never rub firmly.
- 5.) Dab loosened stain substances with a clean, dry part of the cloth and a separate absorbent cloth.
- 6.) In case of stubborn stains and marks, repeat the procedure if required.
- 7.) Finally treat with clean water and dab dry. Place and weight down a dry cloth for absorbing the remaining moisture, if necessary.

**Note:** Persistent water-insoluble or colour intensive stains on textile floor coverings made of natural fibre (pure wool, sisal etc.), which could not be completely removed with Alibaba, might have to be treated with stain removers recommended for synthetic fibre carpeting, if necessary.
